Dear Parents/Guardians,

Arrangements for School Reopening in Term 3 2021

As Singapore moves into Phase 3 (Heightened Alert) with the gradual easing of community Safe Management Measures (SMMs), the Ministry of Education (MOE) will progressively bring students back to school after the June holidays.

To ease into full resumption of school when Term 3 starts on 28 June 2021, students from SPED schools will be staggered to return to school from 28 June to 6 July. As the school's COVID-19 vaccination for students aged 12 years and above is scheduled in Eden School Bukit Batok Campus on 28 & 29 June 2021, the majority of students will be staggered back from 30 June.

Stagger Schedule

All **AMK campus students** have been scheduled for vaccination on 28 June and will return to school from 29 June.

Enhanced SMM Measures

Below is the list of enhanced SMMs that will be put in place to ensure the safety of students and staff when school reopens:

- a) Suspension of face-to-face CCAs and external activities until further notice. Online CCAs at both AMK and BB campuses will resume when term reopens.
- b) Recess will take place in classrooms until further advice on dining in from the government
- c) Conduct of class-based activities to avoid intermingling between classes and cohorts
- d) Use of air purifiers in air-conditioned premises and the daily airing of classrooms and facilities
- e) Sensitization of high touch areas and daily wipe down in classrooms
- f) Daily visual screening by school bus vendors & educators to ensure students are well before boarding of school buses and entering of school premises. Students who present flu symptoms will be asked to seek immediate medical attention and to rest at home.

In view of the greater transmissibility of the new COVID-19 variants, especially with the younger population, you will be required to provide the following supporting document(s) and to keep your child/ward at home in the following situations:

If your child or any of the household members are unwell, please seek immediate medical attention and get tested. Keep your child/ward at home if they are unwell. Our school bus attendants will also be doing visual screening as advised by MOE.

Schools will continue to ensure that enhanced Safe Management Measures (SMMs) are in place to keep our students safe. Students should also have their Trace Together token or app with them throughout the school day to facilitate contact tracing.

Ensure that your child/ward wears a good filtration mask at all times and practise good personal hygiene.

Implementation of EZ Link Card Payment at Eden PBx Cafe

In addition to cash payment, Eden School PBx Café at Bukit Batok campus will start accepting EZ Link card payments when school reopens.

Students on the Financial Assistance Scheme will have their FAS meal vouchers credited into their EZ Link Concession Cards. FAS parents are reminded to submit your child's EZ Link Concession card details and pass your child's EZ Link Concession Card to the class educators when school starts.

We will continue to provide updates as school receives further guidelines from MOE.
